It is a remarkable, restrained wine, with subtle and elegant aromas of tobacco, cedar wood and blackberry, with some fresh red fruit notes. The polished palate is sleek and elegant; the wood is perfectly integrated in the wine, which has both balance and power, and a refined acidity that lifts it up. It has more complexity than the straight Malbec and some edgy tannins. A wine that speaks Spanish with a French accent.
